### STUDENT Classes

- 3. Student 18 years & under as at 17 December 2015 - Any article made from recycled, reused, upcycled material of any medium
- 4. Student 12 years & under as at 17 December 2015 - Any article made from recycled, reused, upcycled material of any medium
- Student/Child 8 years & under as at 17 December 2015 - Any article made from recycled, reused, upcycled material of any medium
- 6. **Group/School Entry** Any article made from recycled, reused, upcycled material of any medium
