- 1. Read Conditions of Entry (page 4) and Special Conditions of Entry for each Art and Photography Sub Section. Please also read the new Identification of Entry Categories on page 8.
- Log on, create a profile and enter your details and exhibits at the following link https://entries.rncas.org.au
   Online entries must be completed and received by the RNCAS Office with the Entry Fees by midnight Saturday 31 January 2026.
- 3. All exhibits must be framed in a suitable surrounding frame/mount (Except side painted stretched canvases) and ready to hang with the actual picture framing string.
- 4. All canvases need to be neat and painted on the sides and strung properly ready to hang
- 5. If you have difficulties paying online please contact the RNCAS Office on (02) 6241 2478
- 6. As soon as possible after entries close you will be sent your Exhibitor Details Letter and your Exhibit Identification Tags by email. You will need to attached these to your artworks/photos.
- 7. Regularly check your Inbox, Spam/Junk folders during the week after the closing date.
- 8. Check that the information on your Exhibitor Details Letter and Exhibit Identification Tags is correct. If it is not correct, contact Section Head (see point 4 for contact info)
- 9. If you have <u>NOT</u> received your Exhibitor Details Letter and Exhibit IdentificationTags by 10 February 2026, contact the office on 02 6241 2478 or email admin@rncas.org.au.
- 10. Attach each Exhibit Id Tag to the front of each relevant exhibit (or as specified).
- 11. Delivery of Exhibits (also bring your Exhibitor Details Letter):
  - a. **either** in person to the Coorong Pavilion EPIC between **9.30 am and 12.30 pm** on Sunday 15 February 2026; **OR**
  - b. by post to CEO (Art and Photography Section), RNCAS, PO Box 124, MITCHELL ACT 2911 to reach the RNCAS Office no later than COB Friday 13 February 2025. IF POSTING AND WISH TO SEND EXHIBITS PRIOR TO RECEIVING LETTER AND TAGS PLEASE EMAIL admin@rncas.org.au for instructions.
  - c. **NOTE**: Art and Photography Competition Section Head must be contacted for alternative delivery arrangements.
- 12. Collection of Exhibits (You MUST bring your Exhibitor Details Letter with you as proof of ownership):
  - a. **either** in person at the Coorong Pavilion EPIC between **8am and 10a**m on Monday 23 February 2026 (strictly NO ADMITTANCE to Coorong Pavilion by exhibitors before 8am); **OR**
  - b. by a person nominated by the Exhibitor. Please leave a signed note with the Chief Steward when delivering your exhibits stating the name of the person who will be collecting on your behalf. This person must bring along the Exhibitor Details Letter to be able to collect the exhibits, **OR**
  - c. exhibits sent by post **must include another self-addressed, paid return satchel -** the exhibit will be posted back to the Exhibitor in the supplied satchel, unless other arrangements have been made with Art Competition Section Head; **OR**
  - d. for those exhibitors living <u>outside</u> the Canberra/Queanbeyan area, exhibits can be collected on Sunday 22 February 2026 between 6.30pm & 7:30pm **ONLY** if **Sunday collection has been requested on the Entry**.
  - e. exhibits not collected will be returned to the RNCAS Office. The RNCAS will not be responsible for exhibits not collected by 4.30 pm Friday 27 February 2026 unless other arrangements are made.
  - f. the Exhibitor Details Letter will be kept by the RNCAS as proof that the exhibitor has taken possession of their exhibit(s).

### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

#### APPLICATION FOR ENTRY:

An exhibitor is not required to be a member of the RNCAS, nor a resident of Australia to be eligible to enter the Art Competition

#### **ENTRIES CLOSE:**

- Entries close Midnight, Saturday 31 January 2026.
- Late Entries will not be accepted.

#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

- All exhibits must be completed after 31 January 2025.
- Exhibits judged at a previous Royal Canberra Show will not be accepted for competition.
- A single painting/exhibit must not be larger than 1m x 1m and presented ready to hang.
- Photographs must be ready to hang and no larger thank 41cm x 51cm, as measured by the inside of the mount/frame size determined by the width of the mount.
- An exhibit cannot be entered in more than one class.
- Student Classes Date of birth must be attached to every student exhibit.
- Entries cannot be transferred from one exhibitor to another.
- An exhibitor may enter more than one exhibit in the same class.
- The exhibitor's name, initials or identifying marks on an exhibit must be masked before delivery.
- Exhibits need to be in clean, unused condition.
- All work on an exhibit is to be the total work of the exhibitor (framing exempt)
- Exhibits that have been partially or fully completed in Class/Seminar or similar must have acknowledgement attached.
- Exhibits that are original designs should have an acknowledgement attached.
- Exhibits that are copies or adaptations <u>must</u> have an acknowledgement of the original artist attached or be accompanied by an illustration.
- Exhibitors are welcome to provide additional information relating to techniques, construction and materials used.
- The RNCAS reserves the right to transfer an exhibit to a more appropriate class or sub section, or to divide classes or combine classes according to the number of entries received.
- The RNCAS reserves the right to withhold any exhibit from being displayed.
- All exhibit identification tags are to be attached firmly clear tape as appropriate
- All exhibits must adhere to the special conditions of entry listed at the beginning of each sub-section.
- Failure to comply with the above conditions & the special conditions of entry for each sub-section may result in your exhibit being disqualified.

#### **SALE OF EXHIBITS:**

The Exhibitor may sell their exhibits. This <u>must</u> be stated when filling out entry details online, together with the selling price. The RNCAS retains a commission of **20%** on all sales.

**JUDGING**: (Judging is NOT open to the public)

Damaged or soiled exhibits will only be accepted at the judge's discretion.

The judge's decision is final, and no further correspondence will be entered into.

Judging will take place on Monday 16 February 2026.
